

## Notice

The consular fee payment method such as Schengen visa application fee, official translation, sign certification etc will change from December 1, 2018.

Until now, paid in cash at the embassy, but from now onwards it is necessary to pay the payment via Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corporation (below with SMBC) to the Hungarian Embassy's account.

Remittance can be either in advance or on the day.

### Remittance in advance

In advance, please remit the consular fee to the embassy's account via SMBC and submit a copy of the application of remittance together with other necessary documents.

### Remittance on the day

Immediately after applying at the embassy, remit the consular fee at the Sumitomo Mitsui Banking Corp., Mitadori branch, nearest from the embassy, and after submitting the remittance, please submit a copy of application form of remittance on a same day.

Due to the embassy's account, it will be treated as foreign remittance. The transfer fee is same with domestic charge and will be borne by the applicant. Also ATM can not be used, so it will be a procedure at the reception desk.

Please refer to a sample of the application form for remittance and obtain same form at SMBC.
